2023-2024 Scholarship Application

A scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who is a member of St. Joseph's Parish in Elk Grove, CA or the Mission Church of St. Vincent de Paul in Rancho Murieta, CA.. The scholarship awarded may be used to offset the costs of either a certified vocational or trade school or a private or public 2-year or 4-year academic institution.

NUMBER OF AWARDS: Two (2) scholarships of \$1000 will be available for the academic year 2023-2024.

The following requirements must be met in order to be considered for the scholarship:

Candidates **MUST** be high school seniors having met the necessary requirements for graduation, and an active parishioner of St. Joseph's Parish in Elk Grove, CA or the Mission Church of St. Vincent de Paul in Rancho Murieta, CA. On separate pages, the candidates must submit a list of activities and an essay with their scholarship application.

LIST of ACTIVITIES (separate sheet): Use 8 ½" x 11" white paper; type or use a computer. Limit the activities to one page and should include activities in and out of school, such as, but not limited to St. Joseph's activities, school activities and clubs, community activities, volunteer services, etc. This is **NOT** an essay but a breakdown of candidate's activities.

ESSAY (separate sheet(s)): Use 8 ½" x 11" white paper; type or use a computer. Limit the essay to two pages (single sided). The theme of the essay will be on how the additional education they are seeking will help them achieve their goals and/or objectives.

TRANSCRIPT: Candidates shall be required to submit a transcript (official or unofficial) of their educational record along with their scholarship application.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: For an application package to be considered, it **MUST** be received in the office either by mail or hand delivered to **St. Joseph Parish Office**, 9961 Elk Grove Florin Road, Elk Grove, CA 95624, no later than 4:00 p.m. on **Friday, April 12, 2024**. Applications hand delivered to St. Joseph Rectory will **NOT** be accepted. The application package will consist of the Scholarship Application, Activities List, Essay and Transcript. **The candidate shall submit the entire package in a sealed envelope. Application packages not enclosed in a sealed envelope will not be reviewed.**

SELECTION: The Elk Grove Knights of Columbus Council #7241 Scholarship Committee, whose decision is final, will select the recipients. The committee will advise the Knights of Columbus officers and the high school scholarship office of the candidates selected. The recipient will be notified by letter of his/her selection by the Grand Knight of the Elk Grove Knights of Columbus Council #7241. Scholarship recipients need to submit the necessary proof of enrollment to either a certified vocational or trade school or a private or public 2-year or 4-year academic institution. Proof of enrollment will have a postmark no later than November 1, 2024. Any scholarship recipient with an enrollment verification postmarked after November 1, 2024 will forfeit the scholarship to The Elk Grove Knights of Columbus Council #7241.
